Does Bhutan Telecom have a 5G network?

Bhutan Telecom has Network Coverage of covering all 20 Districts and National Highways. 5G is the 5th generation mobile network. It is a new global wireless standard after 1G, 2G, 3G, and 4G networks. 5G enables a new kind of network that is designed to connect virtually everyone and everything together including machines, objects, and devices.

What is Telecommunications in Bhutan?

Telecommunications in Bhutan includes telephones, mobiles, radio, television, satellite, and the internet, etc. Recognizing the importance as well as the capital-intensive nature of a contemporary high-speed backbone network in the country, the Government took on itself to establish fiber-optic infrastructure throughout the country.

Where are 5G services implemented in the world?

The fifth-generation 5G services are also implemented in most of the western



countries and according to the Global System for Mobile Communication Association (GSMA), 5G services commercial rollout accounts to 106 globally and it has penetrated almost 7% of the global population with 5G services.

What has Bhutan achieved in the telecommunication sector?

Within two decades Bhutan has achieved a lot in the telecommunication sector starting from having no mobile phones to claiming above mobile penetration, the launching of second-generation networks till the deployment of the fourth-generation network in the country.
