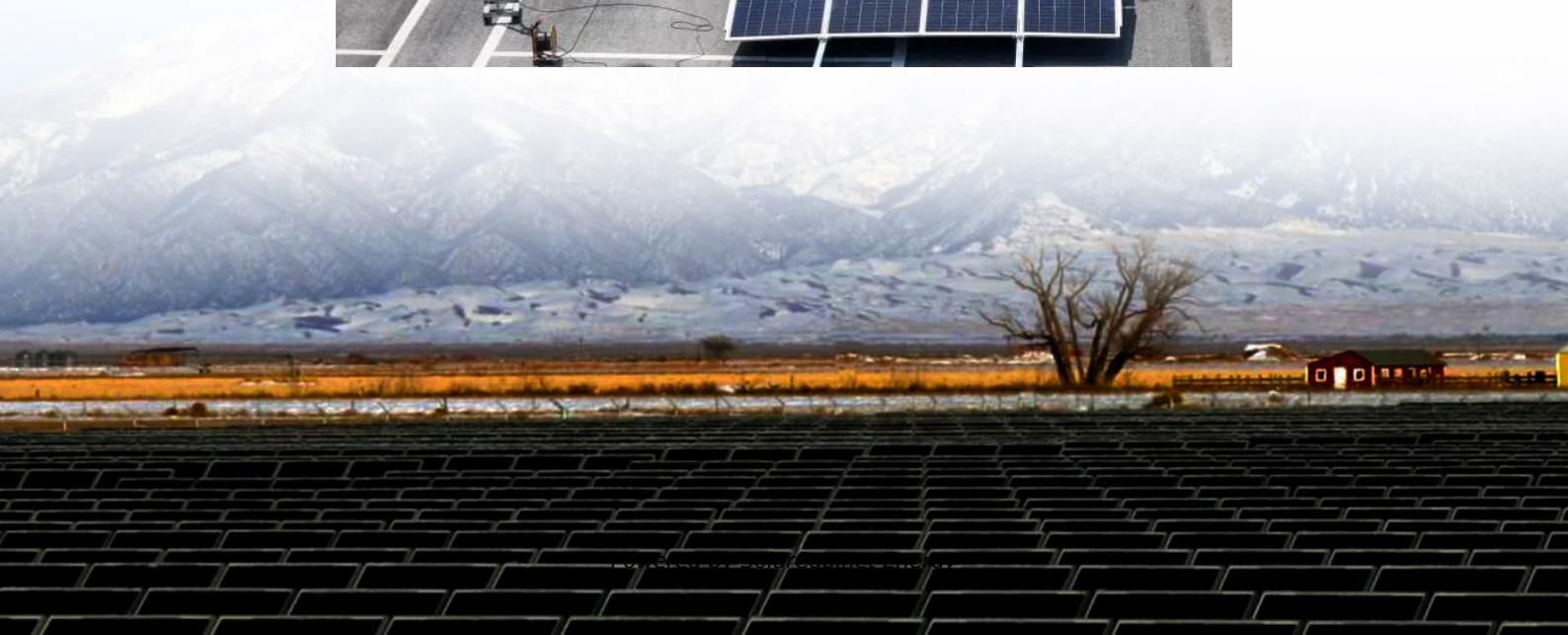


Bring an outdoor power bank when working outside





Overview

For this review, our camping expert tested and reviewed the best power banks for camping to keep your devices charged while you're outdoors.

I've been testing the best power banks for camping in several ways over multiple years. I've taken them on car camping trips, exposing them to sun and wind, with.

After testing out a number of the best power banks in a range of sizes, I'm confident that most people will get the power needs they are looking for with the Anker 511.

Do you need a power bank for camping?

It only takes one dead phone battery to make you realize the importance of a power bank for camping. Whether it's snapping a picture of the local flora and fauna, setting an alarm for your sunrise hike, or pulling up directions for the drive home, it's essential that you have enough juice to last to the end of your trip.

What is the best power bank for camping?

Offline maps. Getting down to less than 10 percent on a camping trip can be a little stressful. The Charge 40 PD was one of the best power banks for camping in the 10,000mAh range during testing, and it has a budget friendly price. The BioLite Charge 20 PD is exactly what you need at the right price.

What are the pros and cons of a USB power bank?

Cons: You won't be able to recharge your phone or other USB devices with spare batteries. If you rely on your phone for navigation, this could be risky. Best for: Backpackers and minimalist campers, Pros: Most camping devices today are charged via USB, so a single power bank could charge all of your devices.

What are the disadvantages of a power bank?

You use the power bank to recharge the batteries. You'll lose some capacity



because of the conversion, so this is not an efficient solution. Another downside is that power banks might not provide enough juice for longer trips. They also won't provide enough juice for high-power devices like photo gear.

How to stay powered while camping?

This is one of the only ways to stay powered while camping for longer periods of time. The solution is also versatile. For example, you can pair an ultralight solar panel with a power bank for backpacking. Or pair a larger solar panel with a power station when on long car camping trips.

Do you need a power bank for a rechargeable battery?

If some of your devices might still use AA or AAA batteries, then you'll have to bring a power bank and spare batteries. Or you bring along a charger for your rechargeable batteries. You use the power bank to recharge the batteries. You'll lose some capacity because of the conversion, so this is not an efficient solution.
