

## Cambodia Siem Reap invests in solar panel project







## **Overview**

Will Cambodia invest 210 billion in solar energy by 2043?

Phnom Penh, Cambodia – The Cambodian government has announced a historic investment plan in solar energy projects worth over 210 billion baht by 2043. This is part of its Power Development Masterplan (PDP) to transition the country towards clean energy and reduce carbon dioxide emissions.

Will China invest in solar in Siem Reap Angkor airport?

During a March 7 meeting with Prime Minister Hun Sen, Liu Minglin, president and vice-chairman of the board of directors of Chinese-owned Yunnan Investment Group – which is also building the Siem Reap Angkor Airport – confirmed his company's intention to invest in the solar sector in Siem Reap.

Are solar power projects a good investment in Cambodia?

Krungthai COMPASS, a financial advisory firm, estimates that solar power projects in Cambodia can generate attractive returns on investment, with an internal rate of return (IRR) ranging from 4.18% to 19.35% and an average payback period of 4.9 to 12.3 years, depending on the electricity selling price offered in the auction.

Can solar power pump clean water from rivers & wells in Cambodia?

(Supplied) Veurn Vouth, program manager of Live and Learn Cambodia, said their project with the community harnesses solar energy to pump clean water from rivers and wells. It benefits eight communities comprising more than 80 families in remote, indigenous areas in Ratanakkiri and Stung Treng provinces.
