Though it's important to note that not all extension cords are the same.

Is it safe to use a high voltage extension cord?

Using an extension cord with a lower voltage rating than required can lead to overheating and potential damage. On the other hand, using a higher voltage-rated cord than necessary is generally safe, but it may be unnecessarily bulky and more expensive.

How do you know if a cord is rated for outdoor use?

You can tell if the cord is rated for outdoor use if the label says "Outdoor Use" or uses the letter indicator "W" -- not to be confused with "O". A letter grade of "W" stands for "weather-resistant" and is meant for outdoor use, "O" on the other hand, simply means that it is oil-resistant.
