But, the higher a home's energy usage, the more solar panels can save the homeowners on their.

The price of solar panels can vary depending on the type of solar panels you choose. There are two main types of solar panels for residential solar installations:.

As of September 2025, the average solar panel system costs \$2.46/W including installation in Georgia. For a 5 kW installation, this comes out to about \$12,293 before incentives, though prices range from \$10,449 to \$14,137. How much do solar panels cost in Georgia?

As of October 2024, the average solar panel system costs \$2.63/W including installation in Georgia. For a 5 kW installation, this comes out to about \$13,173 before incentives, though prices range from \$11,197 to \$15,149. After the federal tax credit, the average price drops by 30%. You'll probably pay even less than what we show here.

Are solar panels a good investment in Georgia?

Solar power is blooming in the Peach State. Georgians use more energy every month than most Americans, which means installing solar panels in the area is more beneficial from a financial perspective than in most states. However, the high solar panel cost in Georgia can be a deterrent for many homeowners.

Can solar panels withstand hail in Georgia?



Solar panels are made from tempered glass, and many manufacturers test the panels to withstand hail that falls at 50 miles per hour. Areas in Georgia that are prone to hailstorms may consider a solar panel cover to offer extra protection. How long do solar panels last in Georgia?

The payback time for solar panels in Georgia is around 12 years, after which you'll be making significant energy savings. And thanks to net metering, if you have a system that generates more energy than you need, you can sell it back to the energy grid and reach full payback a year or two faster.

How much does a power system cost in Georgia?

For Georgia, you can use \$3.52 per watt to determine the price of a larger system (system size x price per watt x 0.7 to account for tax incentives). High Power Bills?

Cost: About \$12,635 for a 5 kW system to \$22,743 for a 9 kW system after tax credit. Savings: 7 year payback; about \$24,566 saved over 20 years.

Should you choose polycrystalline or monocrystalline solar panels?

In areas where sunlight is readily available, homeowners can either choose low-efficiency polycrystalline panels — since the abundant sunlight will still likely mean savings over time — or high-efficiency, monocrystalline panels — to get the best chance of eliminating energy bills and maximizing their production.
