Overview

How do emergency response groups communicate?

Instead, each CERT and jurisdictional office of emergency management has its own protocols for how emergency response groups coordinate communication. This is called a communications plan, and it defines who talks to whom.

What is emergency communications?

Emergency communications is a system of coordinating people and transmitting information to first responders during an emergency. Emergency communications includes: Describe the importance of communications in emergency response. Describe the role of CERT in communications during an activation. How do CERT volunteers communicate with other emergency response agencies?

CERT volunteers act as the “eyes and ears” for other emergency response agencies by communicating through the ICS. A communications plan defines how different levels communicate during an emergency response situation. Different communications modes have different advantages and limitations during an activation.

What does a disaster emergency communications unit do?

The Disaster Emergency Communications unit deploys, installs, operates, maintains and protects telecommunications, logistics, and operations assets in support of planned special events and in response to disasters, assist citizens and first responders.

How many federal agencies are involved in emergency communications?

Its members currently consist of fourteen departments and agencies who represent the federal government’s broad role in emergency communications,



including regulation, policy, operations, grants, and technical assistance.

Do Emergency Response Teams need a communications plan?

However, when multiple teams work together on a larger incident, and those teams must coordinate with other emergency response organizations, we need a plan. A communications plan is a document that defines communications roles and establishes protocols for different groups during an emergency.
