

Home electricity prices in Timor-Leste





Overview

How much does electricity cost in Timor-Leste?

Electricity supply is continually being expanded across Timor-Leste and summarised below: Cost of electricity supply to commercial users is approx. US 24 Cents/kvh. Cost of water supply to commercial users is approx. US 60 Cents/1,000 litres.

Why does Timor-Leste need electricity?

It reflects the nation's growing need for electrical power to support various sectors, including residential, commercial, industrial, and transportation. Over the years, Timor-Leste has witnessed significant shifts in electricity demand due to various factors such as population growth, urbanization, and technological advancements.

Is biomass a source of electricity in East Timor?

Traditional biomass – the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter – is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. East Timor: How much of the country's electricity comes from nuclear power?

Nuclear power – alongside renewables – is a low-carbon source of electricity.

Are there real estate agents in Timor-Leste?

There are no Real Estate Agents in Timor-Leste so searching for privately owned land and property requires some local knowledge. Privately owned land requires direct negotiation with the land owner. How much electricity does Timor-Leste use in 2021?

In total, Timor-Leste used 0.53 Terrawatt hours of electricity in 2021. Demand



increased with a total of 0.03 MWh in 2021, compared to previous year. Between the year 2003 and 2021 the electricity demand in Timor-Leste has grown from 0.06 TW to 0.53 TW, an increase of consumed Terawatt hours by 783.33% in a 18 year time period.

How much land is in Timor-Leste?

Timor-Leste land area is approx.15,000km² of which 10% is arable land. There are a range of regulations regarding the purchase/rent of land in Timor-Leste and these regulations are continually reviewed as the country develops. Government owned land may be leased and involves lodging an application to the Land and Property Office (DNTOSC).
