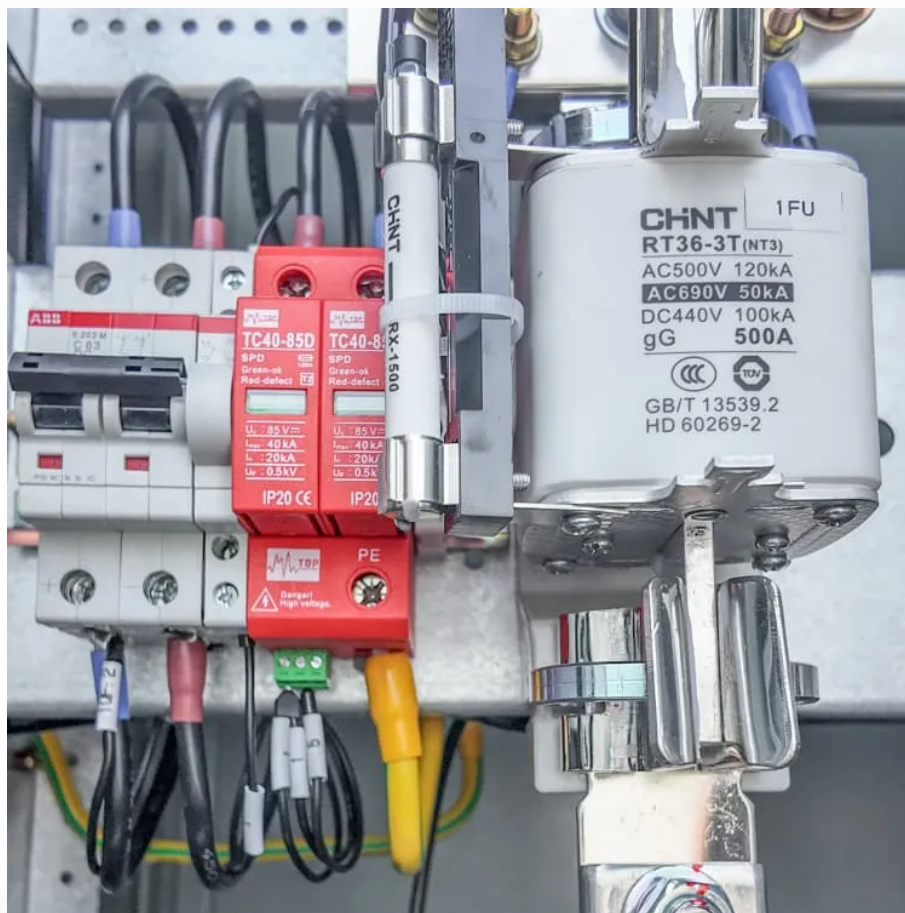


Latest rooftop photovoltaic panel installation

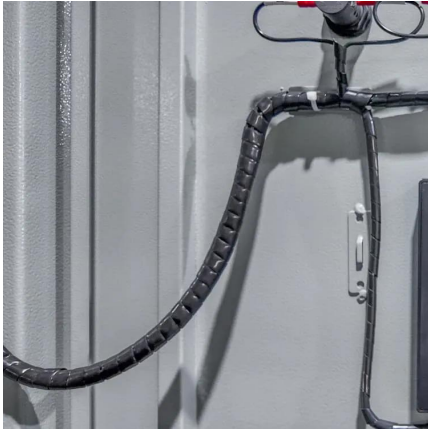
