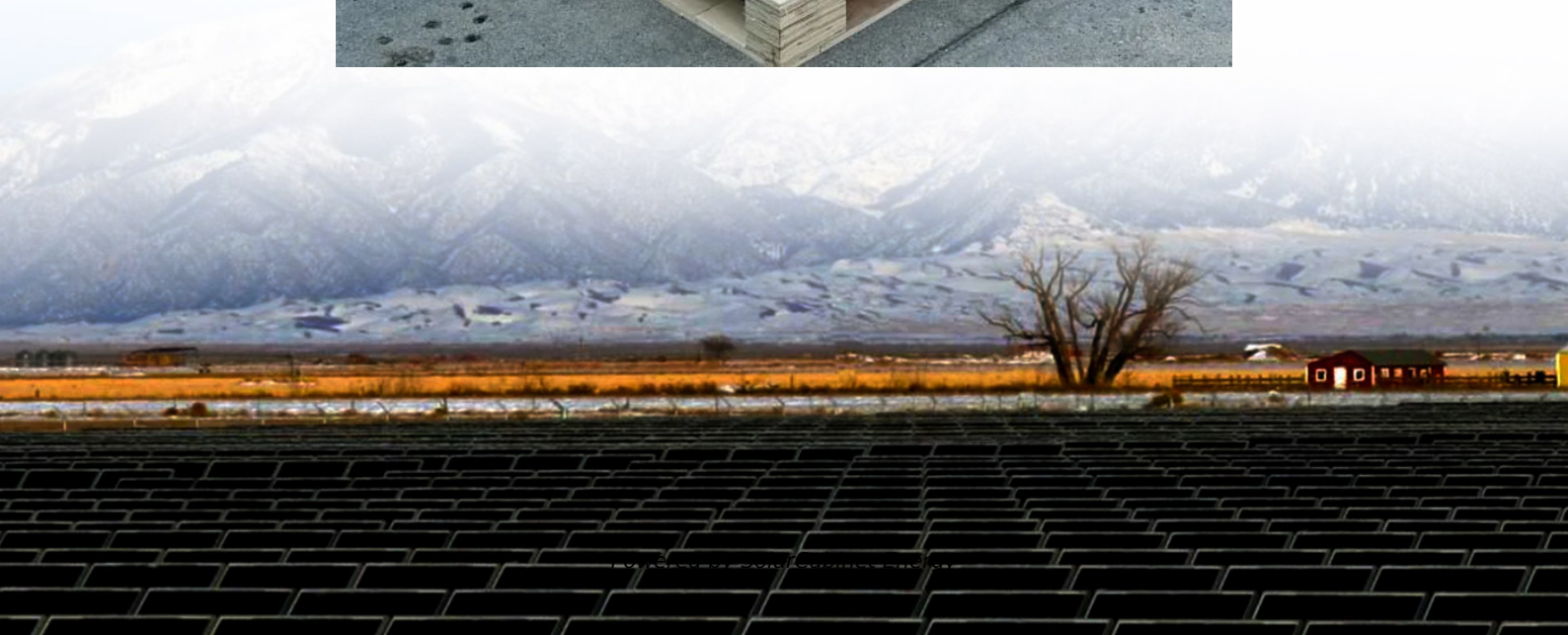


Montenegro about energy storage systems
