

Morocco s first battery energy storage project





Overview

COBCO, a joint venture between CNGR and Al Mada, launched today a two billion dollar lithium-ion battery materials plant in Morocco, the first of its kind outside Asia, as it seeks to become a key supplier for electric vehicle and energy storage markets.



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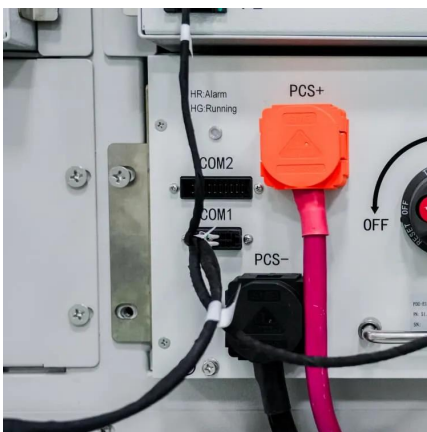

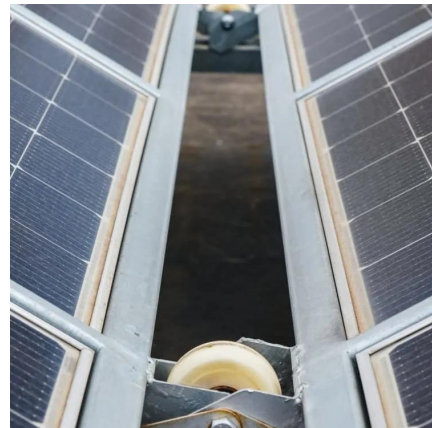
