Overview

Globeleq, majority-owned by British International Investment (BII), began active development on the project in 2019 alongside local partners Source Energia, an energy developer focused on Lusophone Africa, and Electricidade de Moçambique (EDM), the Mozambican national power utility company. In Mozambique, the adoption of solar energy systems is particularly crucial due to several key factors inherent to the country's situation. Firstly, Mozambique has a high solar irradiation level, making it an ideal location for harnessing solar energy.

The US\$36 million Cuamba Solar plant is also Globeleq's first greenfield project in Mozambique and the Group's first combined solar and storage plant in its operating portfolio.

Globeleq, Source Energia and EDM have all invested in this project – a public-private partnership that demonstrates the confidence of international investors in Mozambique.
