

Network base station sites in Moldova





Overview

The mobile telephone market of Moldova is divided between two carriers - Orange Moldova and , and two carriers - and . Orange Moldova launched its network in October 1998 under the brand of Voxtel and was the first and only carrier at the time. In April 2000 entered the market with its own network under the brand of Moldcell and thus.

What is the mobile phone market in Moldova?

The mobile telephone market of Moldova is divided between two GSM carriers - Orange Moldova and Moldcell, and two CDMA carriers - Unité and Interdnestrcom. Orange Moldova launched its network in October 1998 under the brand of Voxtel and was the first and only carrier at the time.

Is LTE available in Moldova?

LTE is also available in Chişinău and select regions and is provided by all carriers. While Moldtelecom and StarNet are major players on the "wired Internet access" market, Orange Moldova, Moldcell and Unité are major players on "mobile Internet access" market.

Which ISPs in Moldova offer internet connection via cable?

SunCommunications and later Orange were the only ISP's in Moldova that offered Internet connection via Cable. The service was available in Chişinău, Bălţi and Cahul but was discontinued in the early 2020's in favor of FTTx. StarNet is the pioneer of this technology in Moldova. It was the first ISP that began offering Internet connection via FTTx.

When did Interdnestrcom launch a commercial LTE network in Moldova?

On April 21, Interdnestrcom becomes the first carrier in the country to launch a commercial LTE network. On November 20, Orange became the second carrier in the country and, officially, the first in Moldova to successfully launch a commercial LTE network.

Does Moldova have a good internet connection?



As far as the Internet is concerned, Moldova has one of the best wired Internet connections in the world as well as one of the cheapest in \$ per Mbit. After the break of the Soviet Union Moldova 's telecommunications facilities were in a very poor condition.

How many people in Moldova have broadband?

In 2018, 49% of Moldovan households had broadband access. In 2015, there were 80 registered Internet Service Provider 's (ISP's) in the country, with the majority being local or regional with only a few offering their services throughout the country.

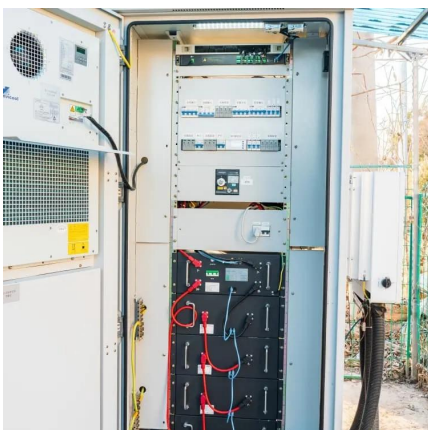
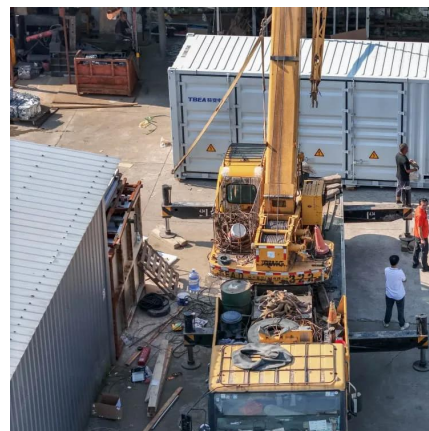
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
