

Outdoor power light recommendation







Overview

How do I choose the best outdoor lighting?

Some standalone lanterns can easily be toppled by a strong wind. String lighting adds a soft glow and gives off a magical outdoor vibe. String lights look great suspended from a ceiling or wrapped around a deck banister, column or tree. If you're looking for a good amount of light with pretty ambiance, opt for larger bulbs.

What voltage is best for outdoor lighting?

Different voltages are ideal for different needs. If your lighting is intended to guide you through a specific task, like outdoor grilling or home security, a high-voltage fixture is probably best. For something more decorative and ambient, low-voltage fixtures should be sufficient. Most outdoor lights are either battery powered or solar powered.

How much wattage do outdoor lights need?

Before calculating wattage requirements, you'll need to identify exactly why you're installing outdoor lights. Security lighting typically requires higher wattage (50-100 watts for traditional bulbs or 10-20 watts for LEDs) to illuminate larger areas and deter intruders.

What wattage should I use for patio lighting?

What's the recommended wattage for patio and deck lighting?

For deck and patio lighting, use varied wattage based on function: 10-15 watts LED per 100 square feet for general illumination, 5-7 watts LED for step lights, and 8-12 watts for task lighting areas (grilling or dining spaces).

What are the different types of outdoor lighting?

Two of the most common types you'll see are dusk-to-dawn lighting and motion-activated lighting. Dusk-to-dawn lighting is triggered by sundown and



is primarily used to keep lights on overnight. Aside from enhancing outdoor security and providing exterior illumination, this feature conserves energy by staying off when the sun's out.

Are outdoor lights wired or battery-powered?

Outdoor lights are either wired, solar-powered, or battery-operated. With the move toward LEDs and better rechargeable batteries, solar-powered lights are becoming more popular. They're ideal for remote applications and installations where you don't want to install extra wiring, but they aren't as bright as wired or battery-powered options.
