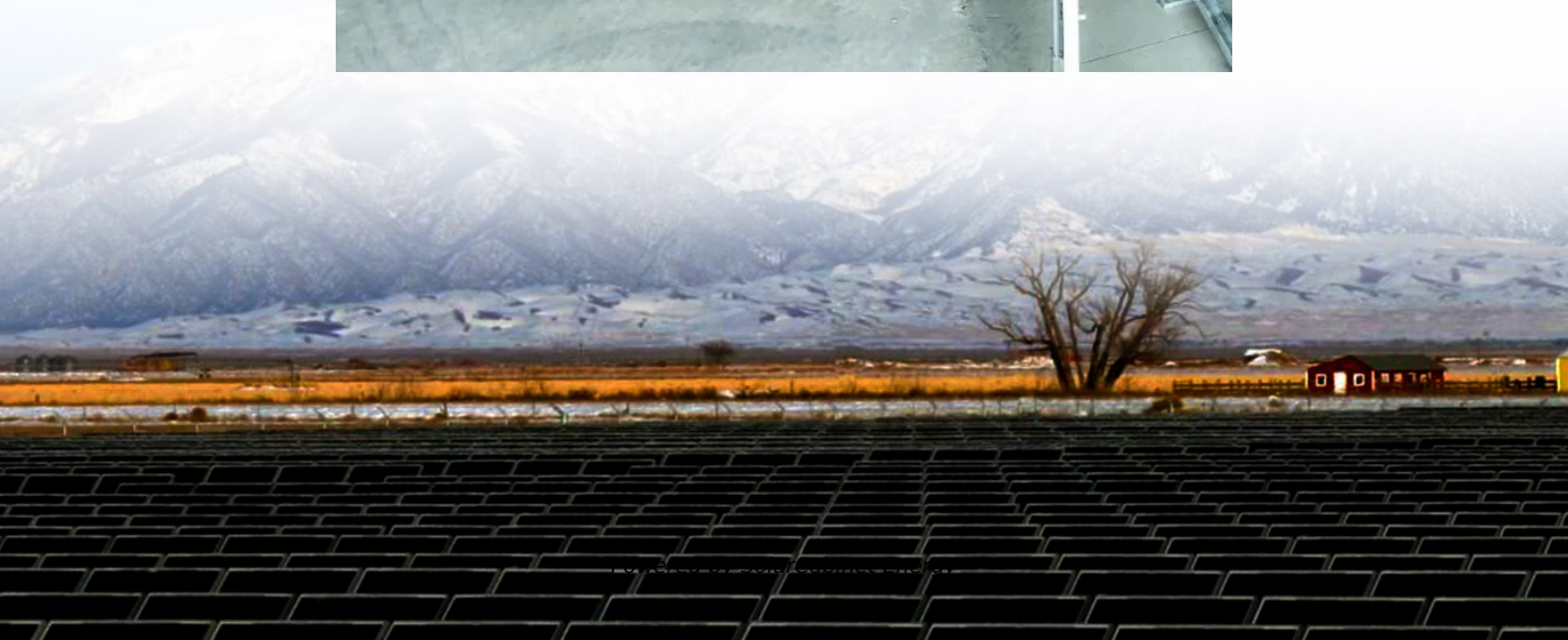


Solar photovoltaic panels cope with strong winds
