

## Uzbekistan containerized energy storage







## **Overview**

Uzbekistan's first energy storage facility, with a 150 MW capacity, will launch in the Fergana region in January 2025, according to the National News Agency (UzA). Construction began in the summer of 2024, featuring a storage system with a distribution unit and 90 battery modules. Will Uzbekistan fund a 250-megawatt solar photovoltaic plant?

TASHKENT, May 21, 2024 — The World Bank Group, Abu Dhabi Future Energy Company PJSC (Masdar), and the Government of Uzbekistan have signed a financial package to fund a 250-megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic plant with a 63-MW battery energy storage system (BESS).

How will Uzbekistan improve its energy security?

"This project will enhance Uzbekistan's energy security through the use of innovative solutions and technologies," noted Marco Mantovanelli, World Bank Country Manager for Uzbekistan.

Who will sell electricity to in Uzbekistan?

The project company is committed to selling electricity to the state-owned National Electric Grid of Uzbekistan JSC under a 25-year Power Purchase Agreement for the project, including a 10-year operating term for the BESS component, signed by these two entities.
